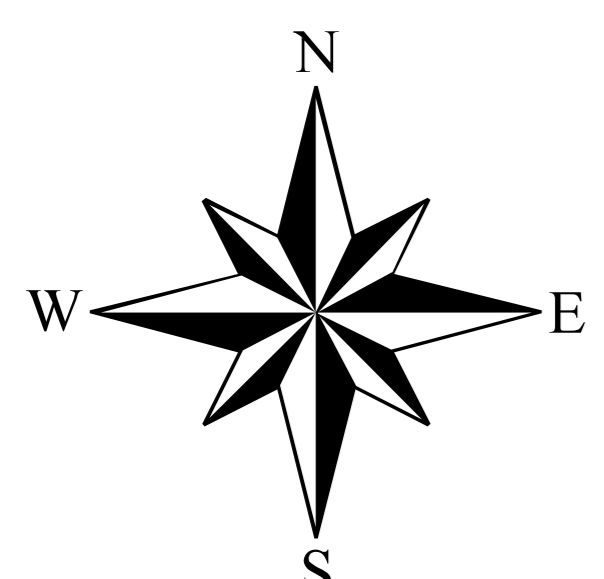
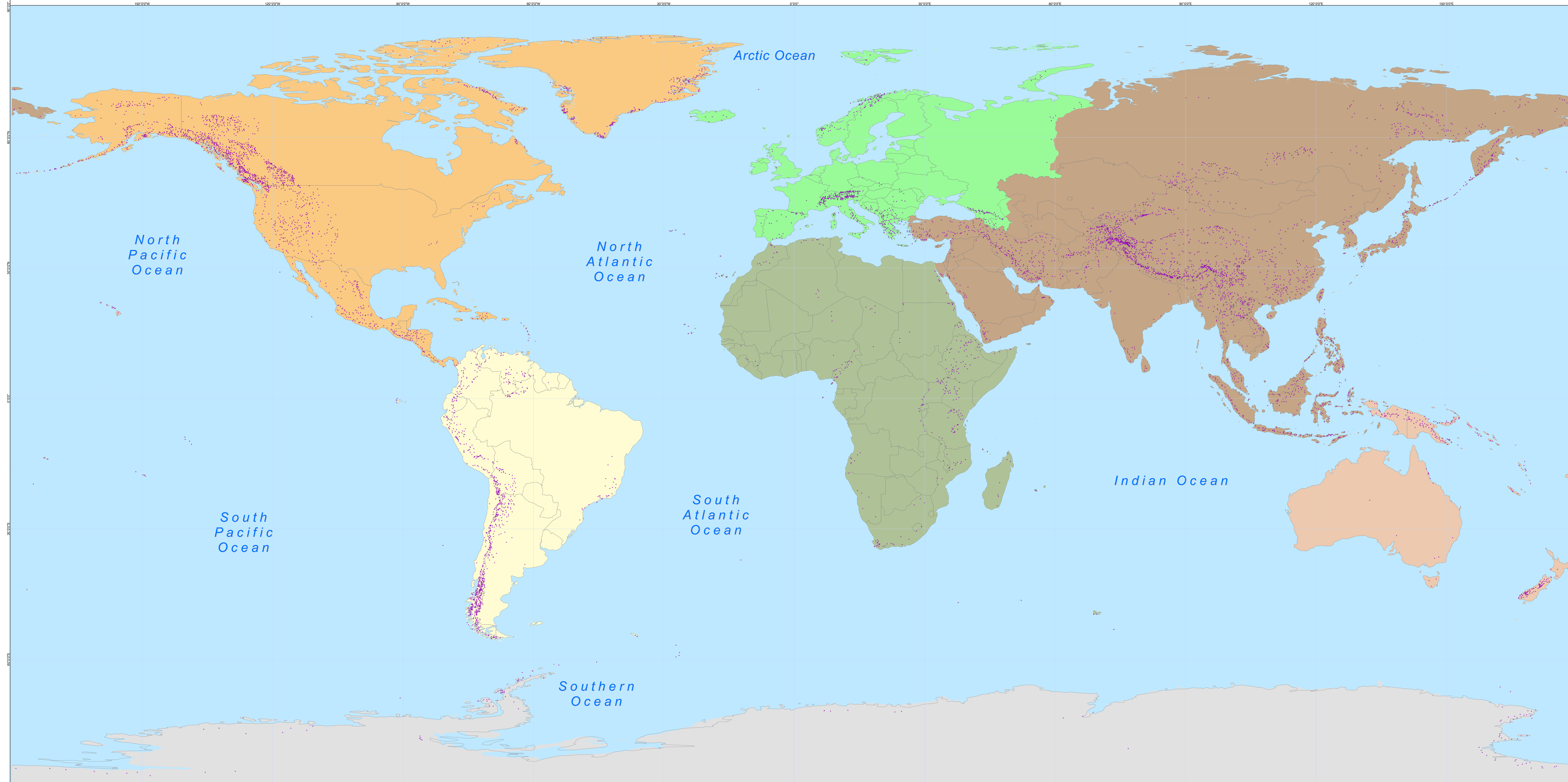


# Ribus of the World

Antarctica	116	Mount Vinson – 4892m, P4892
