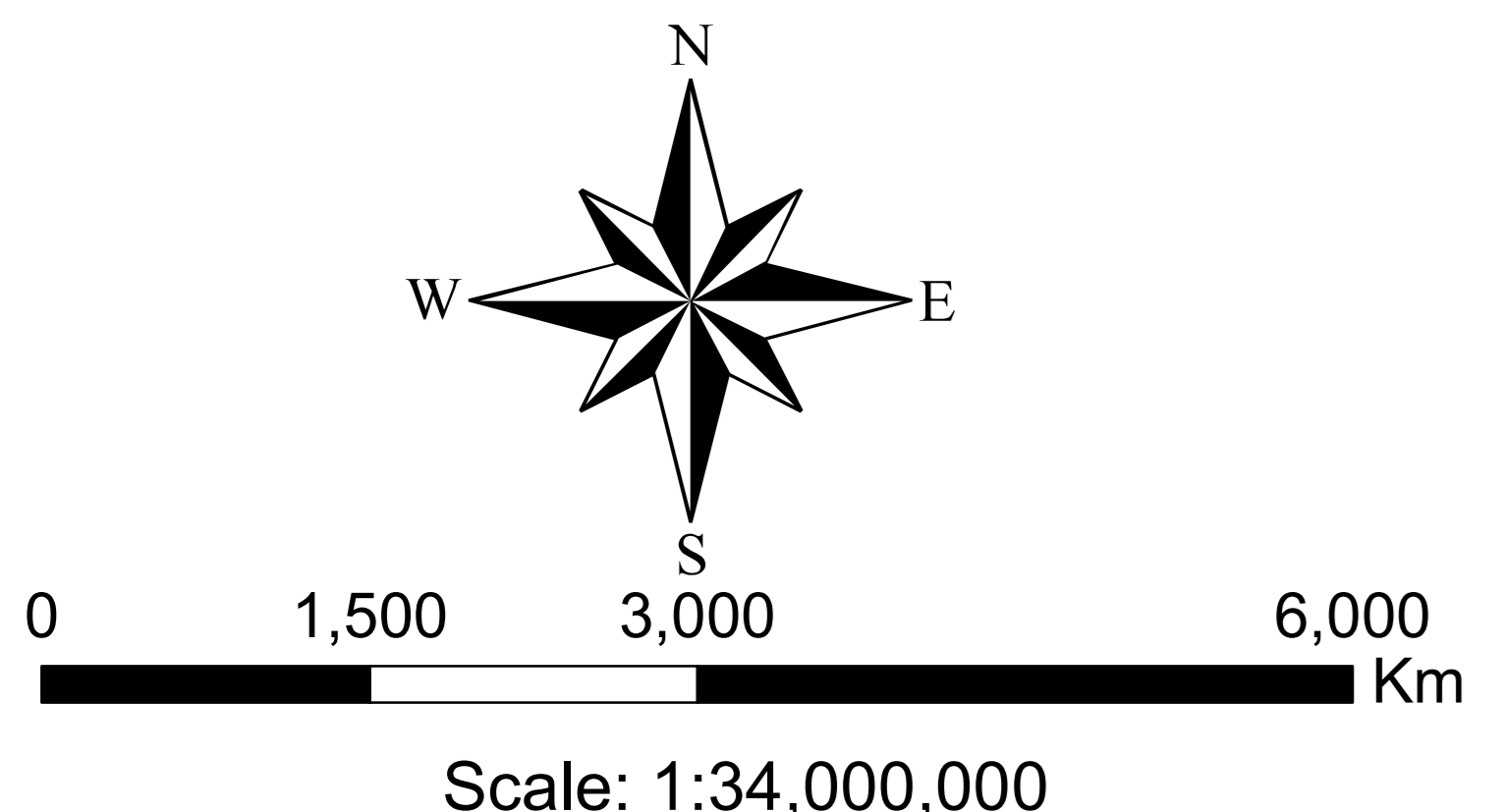
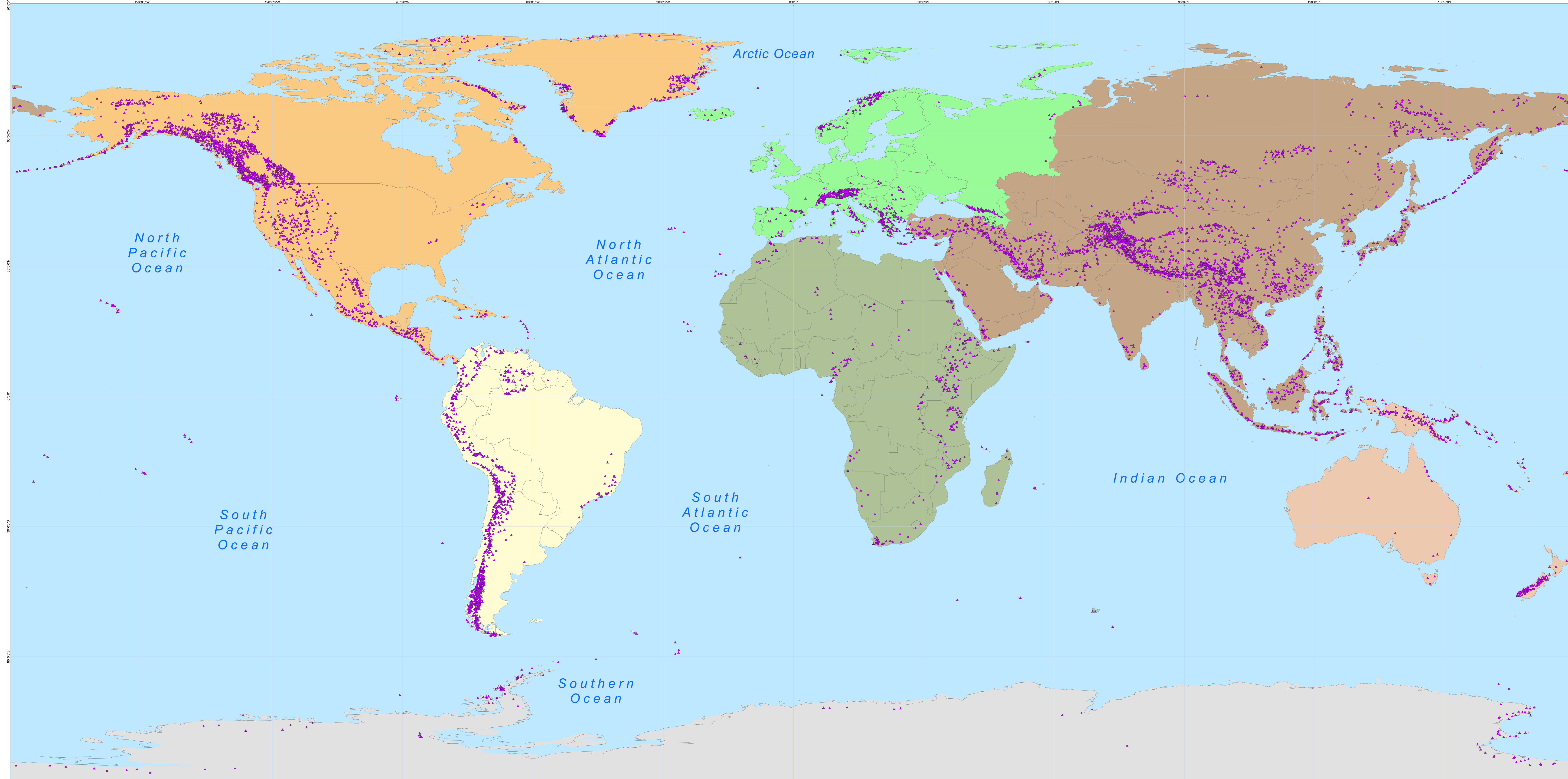


Ribus of the World
